PROFESSIONAL SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR & STAFF

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Services included, but not limited to: (1) responding to the initial request for service; (2) conducting the arrangement conference; (3) preparation of biographical and statistical data; (4) explanation of charges and examination of financial settlement options; (5) preparation and filing of papers, permits and authorizations; (6) coordination with those providing other services; (7) preparation and placement of obituary notices; (8) retention and care of remains prior to commencement of post-death activities; (9) overhead expenses relative to our facilities and operations, such as occupancy, administrative and equipment costs.

Professional Services

In addition to the professional services outlined in our general price list, our services also include:

- Staff response 24 hours per day, 365 days per year to initial requests for services. Conducting the arrangement conference with the responsible party(ies) to gather death certificate information and determine desired services.
- Coordinating desired service plans with the cemetery, crematory, clergy, fraternal lodges, military, civic organizations, and/or other parties involved in the ceremonies, rituals, transportation, and final disposition of the deceased.
- Preparation of the death notice and obituary, transcripts of death, clergy record, Social Security notification, veterans' application(s), airline notifications, legal affidavits and any other forms or correspondence requested by the family or required by 3rd parties.
- Access to Groce Funeral Home's website (<u>www.grocefuneralhome.com</u>) and online obituary and quest register book services.
- Dedicated and caring staff who regularly receive continuing education and professional training to meet state and federal licensing requirements.

Basic Unallocated Funeral Provider Overhead

Also included within our professional services fee is our basic unallocated funeral home overhead which covers fixed overhead and includes a pro-rata share of the costs for insurance, taxes, telephone and communications, secretarial and office expenses, maintenance, professional licensing and training, legal, accounting and other fixed expenses.

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Embalming procedures

Our NC licensed embalmers use "Best Management Practices" and "Universal Precautions" as required by the blood-borne Pathogens Regulations of OSHA and the NC State Board of Funeral Service. Our fee includes the use of chemical supplies, equipment, emergency equipment for compliance with OSHA regulations for formaldehyde exposure, blood-borne pathogen exposure, workplace safety and disposal of regulated medical waste.

REFRIGERATION (WHEN EMBALMING NOT SELECTED)

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are fiberboard.

Our charges for a direct cremation include transfer of remains to the funeral home, Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, refrigeration, and crematory fee (\$820). This charge does not include stateroom, rites, or ceremonies.

ECO-HYDROLYSIS

Groce Funeral Home is proud to offer eco-hydrolysis (also known as green cremation, water cremation and flameless cremation), a gentler and more environmentally friendly alternative to flame-based cremation.

A combination of water, temperature, and alkalinity are used to accelerate the breakdown of organic materials, the same as natural breakdown, but in a much faster timeframe. The eco-hydrolysis process is performed after any viewing that the family requests. The body is respectfully placed in a stainless steel vessel, after being wrapped in a specially designed water-soluble covering. Alkali is added and the vessel fills with water. The solution of 95% water and 5% alkali is heated to 200-300°F, and gently circulated for the entire length of the process, usually 5-6 hours. Unlike flame-based cremation, eco-hydrolysis produces no greenhouse gases and doesn't burn fossil fuels. It's 90% more energy efficient than flame-based cremation and uses 1/10th of the carbon footprint.

At the end of the process, the sterile water is released for recycling. When the operator opens the door, only the inorganic bone minerals remain. These minerals are processed into powder and returned to the family in an urn. This final processing step is the same process that is followed with flame cremation. Families may choose to have services, burial or scattering of ashes, just the same as those who choose flame cremation.

SIMPLE ECO-HYDROLYSIS

Our charges for a simple eco-hydrolysis include transfer of remains to the funeral home, Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, use of refrigeration, eco-hydrolysis facility fee and water-soluble covering. This charge does not include stateroom, rites or ceremonies.
